This lecture will explore the latest developments on the controversial issue of hate speech in European law, both on the level of the Council of Europe and most recently in EU non-discrimination law.

Dr. Belavusau holds a Ph.D. from the European University Institute (Florence, Italy) and an LL.M. from the Collège d'Europe (Bruges, Belgium). He was a visiting scholar at both the University of California at Berkeley (USA) and Max-Planck-Institut für ausländisches öffentliches Recht und Völkerrecht (Heidelberg, Germany)
