Dr. Sevasti Trubeta is Assistant Professor of Sociology at the University of the Aegean in Greece. Her research interests include issues of Humanitarianism, biopolitics, eugenics, Roma, Refugees, with a regional focus on South Eastern Europe.

While at York, Dr. Trubeta will be working on a project entitled “Social Inequality and Creation of the Perfect Human – Comparison of Eugenics and New Reproductive Technologies (IVF).” This project combines ideas springing out of her previous work on eugenics and the social issues attached to it (with a regional focus on Southeastern Europe) and her present research in global dimensions of social inequality in application of reproductive technologies, with a special focus on fertility (sperm donation, in vitro fertilization). From an epistemological point of view, the approach is multidisciplinary since it involves disciplines such as social history of medicine, sociology of social inequity and sociology of the body and human reproduction.
